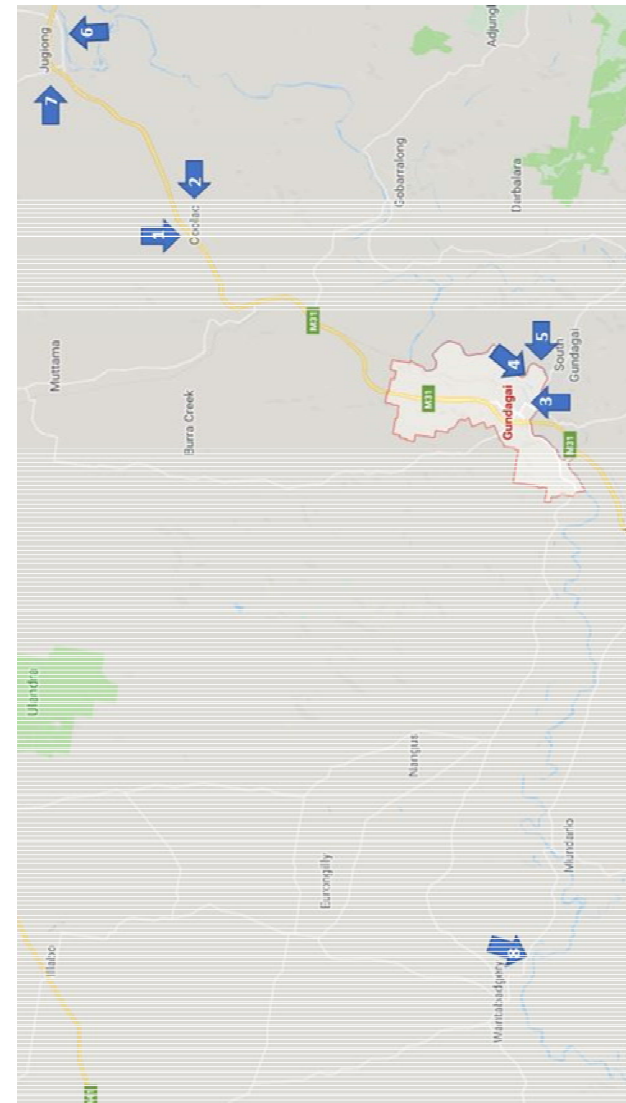

Gundagai is a classic Australian country town situated on the Murrumbidgee River between Sydney and Melbourne, in one of the most picturesque rural areas of the Riverina, in southern New South Wales (NSW). Gundagai is centrally located to all south eastern capital cities and on the Hume Highway making it easy to get to. We are a one and a half hour drive from Canberra, four hours from Sydney and five hours from Melbourne.

Gundagai RV FREE Campsites

1.Beehive Motel/Hotel: Hume Highway, Coolac 2727. Dog friendly, toilets, bins, Free camping and RV's, phone reception. Small area behind/alongside Hotel with good facilities.

2.Coolac Recreation Reserve: School Road, Coolac 2727. Toilets with disabled access, dog friendly, free camping and RV's, picnic tables, phone reception. Large area with limited facilities.

3.Morley's Creek Camp: Homer Street, Gundagai 2722. Dog friendly, free camping and RV, phone reception, shaded areas. 48 hours stay. Medium creek front area, with limited facilities.

4.Gundagai Pump Reserve: 2km East of Gundagai, 2722. Dog friendly, free camping and RV. 72 hours stay. Medium creek front, with no facilities.

5.Gundagai Dump Site: Railway Pde, Gundagai 2722. Fresh water tap available.

6.Jugiong Rest Area: Camp area at Jugiong behind local pool. Toilet facilities, drinking water, bins, phone reception, shaded area and picnic tables, dog friendly, free camping and RV. A large area next to the river.

7.Jugiong Dump Site: Old Hume Highway, Jugiong.

8.Sandy Beach: 3km South-West of Wantabadgery on River Road. Toilets with disabled access, bins, shaded areas with picnic tables, dog friendly, Free camping and RV. Large riverfront area with good facilities.

COOTAMUNDRA RV FREE CAMPS

1.Cujigong Creek Rest Area: 12km North East of Bethungra, 12km South West of Cootamundra. Bins, phone reception, shaded areas, picnic tables, dog friendly, free camping.

2.Bethungra Dam & Reserve: T/O 500m North of Bethungra under railway bridge on Water Works. Toilets, dog friendly, bins, picnic tables, shaded areas, Free camping and RV. Large area around dam, with good facilities.

3.Illabo Rest Area: Rest area at Illabo. Toilets, bins, phone reception, shaded areas, picnic tables, water, dog friendly, RV parking. Medium area with good facilities.

4.Springdale Memorial Park: Burley Griffin Way, Springdale. Toilets with disabled access, bins, phone reception, shaded areas, picnic tables, water, dog friendly, RV parking.

5.Cootamundra Dump Site: Apex Park, Hurley Street Cootamundra.
